




SO FAR IN 2018

The speakers included Democratic Leader Nancy Pelosi, Republican Conference Chair Cathy McMorris Rodgers, and Women's Caucus Co-Chairs Reps. Susan Brooks and Lois Frankel. We were honored to host 400 attendees, including current and former women Members of Congress, as well as federal agency officials, corporate and labor supporters, senior congressional staff, and women's groups.

This year 13 Members of Congress and 15 girls participated in the [Congressional Take Our Daughters to Congress Day](#). The girls shadowed women Members of Congress for a day and learned how the legislative branch

functions up close. This partnership with Girls Inc. allows girls, aged 9-17, to see women's leadership and envision themselves as leaders in their communities.

Approximately 200 attended the event, including five Members of Congress, federal agency representatives, corporate and labor supporters, congressional staff, and women's and STEAM advocacy organization leaders.
