## Washington State Department of Washington's Women Snapshot Health

### Women make up 50.1% of the population.

.6 million girls under 15

1.3 million women ages 15-44

1.4 million women over 45







## Washington Women's Health

#### 2011:

59% ages 18–44 years reported their general health as very good.

16% said their mental health was not good for two or more weeks during the previous month.

#### 2010:

17% ages 15–44 years reported household incomes below the federal poverty level and 35% were below 200%.







## **Clark County Snapshot**

Tobacco-free living Since January 1, 2013, an estimated **630** more people live in multifamily housing that has become smoke-free with the help of Clark County Public Health.




**2** neighborhoods, home to

**8,900** people, have partnered to implement smoke-free parks.



4 out of 5 Clark County residents visit a park each year.

Clark County's **8** healthy neighborhood stores have given about **9,000** people access to healthy food within ½ mile of their homes.



In 2012, SNAP shoppers visited farmers markets

**2,307** times, making

\$43,866 in

purchases.



3 of Clark County's 8 farmer's markets accept SNAP benefits.

Walk or bike to school programs and community support have provided

approximately **530** students with opportunities to walk or bike to Walnut Grove Elementary School.



In a 1-year period, over

**1,000** students and their families participated in Safe Routes to School events.



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
