Congresswoman Nita M. Lowey has represented the Lower Hudson Valley since her election in 1988. She is the first woman to chair the House Appropriations Committee. A co-chair of the Women's Caucus in the 104th Congress, she has been a champion of women's issues throughout her career, particularly increased funding for breast cancer research and education.
